Southern Country Golf Association 2021 RHL Roberts Memorial Trophy Championship Conditions

1. Entries

- 1.1 Entrance fee must be paid at the time of entry.
- 1.2 Entries must be made on the attached entry form and must be countersigned by the Secretary or Club Official of the entrant's club.
- 1.3 Entries must be made with the Secretary, Southern Country Golf Association, PO Box 301 Rosny Park, 7018 (3 Springvale Avenue, New Town) not later than 5.00pm on Wednesday 18 August, 2021.
- 1.4 Clubs are invited to enter a team of two players with **preference** given to your Foursomes Champions of each club or the Runner-Up Champions. Should the Champions or runners up be unavailable substitutes will be permitted, however, substitutions will not be allowed after the first round has commenced
- 1.5 The SCGA reserves the right to refuse any entry without assigning any reason for so doing.
- 1.6 The draw will be sent by email to each club which will be responsible for notifying its players.
- 1.7 All events shall be under the entire control of the SCGA which shall have full power to alter or make any variations to the conditions, or alter the time fixed for starting any event as indicated in the programme.

2. Rules

The Rules of Golf, as adopted by R&A Rules Limited, will apply together with such local rules as are approved by the Championship Committee.

3. Handicaps

- 3.1 All competitors must hold an official Amateur Australian handicap.

4. Draw and Starting Times

- 4.1 Rule 5-3a provides: - "The player shall start at the time laid down by the Committee". The penalty for breach of Rule 5-3a is disqualification. However, it is a condition of this Championship that, in the absence of circumstances which warrant waiving the penalty of disqualification as provided in Rule 5.3a, if the player arrives at his starting point, ready to play, within five minutes of his starting time, the penalty for failure to start on time is loss of one hole, instead of disqualification.
- 4.2 Play will commence at approximately 8.00am and 12.30pm approx. on Sunday 29 August and at 8.00am and 12.30pm on Sunday 12 September, with one tee being used.
- 4.3 The SCGA may, in the event of bad weather, or for any other reason, cancel or fix another date and/or venue for this tournament or any part thereof.

5. Golf Balls

- 5.1 It will be obligatory for all competitors in the Championship to play with a golf ball which is named in the current R&A and/or USGA approved lists.

6. Format

- 6.1 First 18 hole shall be Foursome Stroke play with the best 8 teams to qualify for the match play.
- 6.2 A seeded draw for round two.
- 6.3 Foursomes Match-Play Knock-Out.
- 6.4 Should a game be all square after 18 holes, the game must be played to the finish, sudden death

7. Protests

All protests must be lodged in writing at the club house, within 5 minutes of the conclusion of the day's play on which the disputed matter has arisen, and the decision of the SCGA Match Committee on all points shall be final.

8. Membership Privileges

- 8.1. Competitors will be made Honorary Members, without fee, of the host club on the day of the event.
- 8.2 Competitors are required to observe the dress regulations of the host club at all times.

9. Motorised Transport

During a round, competitors may not travel in or on any motorised vehicle. Any player who is aged 55 years or over is exempt from this condition and may travel in or on a motorised vehicle.

10. Driving Clubs

The driver the player carries must have a club head, identified by model and loft that is named on the current List of Conforming Driver Heads issued by R&A Rules Limited.

NOTE: Any individual driver on the list, if tested on pendulum apparatus approved by R&A Rules Limited must not have a characteristic time greater than 257 microseconds. (The list may be viewed at www.golfaustralia.org.au)

11. Drug Testing

All competitors are subject to drug testing by the Australian Sports Anti-Doping Agency for banned substances as laid down in Golf Australia's Anti-Doping Policy. Any competitor infringing this policy, or refusing to take a test, will be disqualified and subject to any sanction(s) brought down by ASADA. 12. Measuring Devices

The use of measuring devices that permit the measurement of **distance only** is permitted during the play of this event.
